ONLINE APPLICATION PROCESS

IMPORTANT:

We will only review applications that are <u>fully COMPLETED online</u> and once the <u>application fee</u> of ZAR 200.00 is paid to the University by the closing date. Incomplete applications and applications submitted after the closing date will not be reviewed.

INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS

Your application must include the SAQA Evaluation Certificate for qualifications obtained outside of South Africa, or proof that you have applied to SAQA for evaluation. Without proof of submission to SAQA applications will not be reviewed.

You must start the SAQA process before you submit your application to GLU. If you have not received the evaluation certificate, you must include proof that you have applied to SAQA with your application.
